What is the Birth to 3 program?

- Services for children from birth to their 3rd birthday
- Children qualify for services if they have delays or a diagnosed disability
- Staff do an evaluation to see if your child qualifies.
- Staff look at how your child plays, learns, speaks, acts, and moves.

Why is the Birth to 3 program helpful?

- Early intervention is helpful for developmental concerns
- A team supports your family.
- The main person who works with you during home visits is your primary coach
- Birth to 3 program staff give you ideas on how to help your child.
- You don't have to be an expert!

What else is important to know about the Birth to 3 program?

- Services are in your child's natural environment, like your home, a family member's home, or daycare
- Services are personalized for your child
- Families are an important part of the Birth to 3 Program

How do you connect with the Birth to 3 program?

- Each county in Wisconsin has a Birth to 3 Program.
- You, a doctor, or someone else who knows your child can make a referral
