

Outpatient Therapy

What is Outpatient Therapy?

- Speech, occupational or physical therapy
- Provided in a clinic

Why is it helpful?

- Works on specific skills your child needs
- Can work with Birth-3 or school therapist too

What is important to know?

- Paid for by private health insurance or Medicaid

How do you connect to Outpatient Therapy?

- Need written referral from primary care provider
- Therapy clinic will schedule an evaluation, then set goals for your child
- How often therapy occurs depends on:
 - Your child's needs
 - Your schedule
 - The therapist's schedule
- Work your child's therapy activities into their play at home
